# Positive Behaviour for learning - PBL



**PBL - Positive Behaviour for Learning - is a whole school approach to creating a positive, safe and supportive environment, where all students can learn and develop.**

**Our behaviours are always guided by our values of  
**Safety, Respect and Responsibility****

**To create a calm, consistent and safe learning environment, everyone is taught expected behaviours and are responsible for following them. Students are celebrated for demonstrating positive behaviours.**

**In creating and maintaining a calm, consistent and safe learning environment, if a student is involved in a physical interaction the following will occur:**

- The student will be removed from class. The student will be taught the expected behaviours and ways they can respond differently next time.**
- The staff member who dealt with the behaviour will contact the parent/s to organise a re-entry meeting for the parent to join with us to help the student.**
- The student will be unable to return to class until this meeting has occurred.**
- During this meeting we will have the student and their parent/s, classroom teacher and a leadership member of staff to agree on the expected behaviour and some self-regulated strategies to help the student.**
- These meetings will be documented so we can ensure success as the student learn our expected behaviours.**

feel.

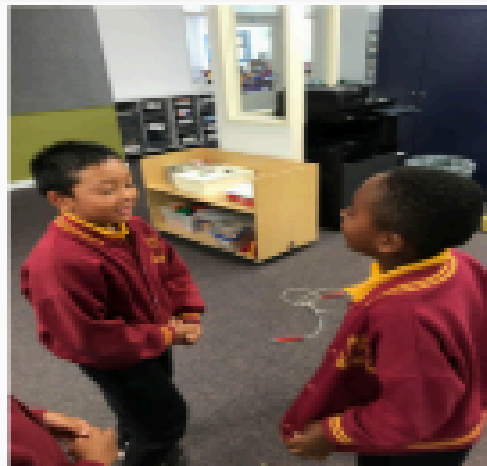
I am angry with you because...

Say: "It doesn't matter."

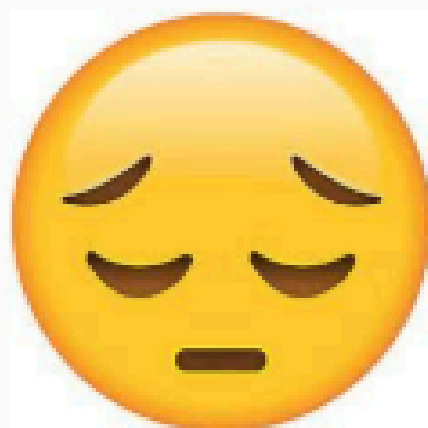




When I am being physical with someone this may include pushing, hitting, slapping and shoving.
